RISE is working to help Manik's family receive additional Government Benefits to build a toilet as well as avail of rations and subsidies to support the family.

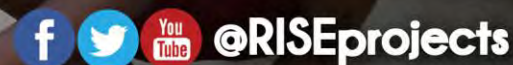
